Double-Blind Peer Review

Anonymized articles are sent to two experts in the field for their evaluation.

***This is the longest part of the process because we depend on the schedules of reviewers who are suitable, available, willing, and do not know the author.*

Revision

- Authors make revisions based on the suggestions of peer reviewers and editors.
- They send the article back to *Contributions*.
- The editors review the revisions to ensure they are in line with the suggestions of peer reviewers.

Articles Submitted to the Publisher

- The article is typeset.
- A PDF is provided for final approval prior to publishing.

***No major changes are allowed at this time.*

Desk Review

Our editors review an article to determine if it is in scope for our journal and if it has a good chance of passing peer review.

Evaluate the Reviews

Option 1: If the article does not pass peer review, the article will not be published.
Option 2: The editors evaluate the reviews and make suggestions for revision.

Language Editing

This is the first step in the publishing process with the publisher.

- The article will be edited to conform to the *Contributions* style guide and make any other adjustments prior to submission to the publisher.
- Authors approve these changes. ***This is the final chance to make any significant changes.***
